SPAN 181

Introduction to Spanish for Heritage Speakers

PREREQUISITES:

Requires exposure to Spanish in the home or the neighborhood. Not open to native speakers (with high school diploma from a Spanish-speaking country) or students with credit in SPAN 201, SPAN 202, SPAN 211, SPAN 282, SPAN 301, or higher-level course.

Replaces SPAN 101 and SPAN 102 for preparation for the major.

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

Strong emphasis in developing listening and speaking skills while practicing basic grammar structures in the heritage language, and cultivation of positive attitudes towards the heritage language and the heritage culture.

- US Latinx experiences
- Language and identity
- Migration
- Spanish in the US
- The borderland
- Transnational experiences
